Nackawic-Millville Music Festival will be held April 14-15 using an area church and local schools as venues. The online registration deadline for entering is February 8, 2026. The syllabus for the 2026 Nackawic-Millville Music Festival is currently available on-line at <http://www.nbfmf.org/nackawic-music-festival/>. Competition will be offered at various levels from beginner to advanced, in the following disciplines: Voice, Piano, Strings, Guitar, Woodwind, Brass, Percussion, Chamber Ensemble, Musical Theatre, Speech Arts, Choral, Band, Orchestra and Dance. Each performance will be adjudicated and receive instruction from a specialist in the discipline. Students, classes, bands, and choirs are encouraged to participate in the festival. If they are interested and/or need assistance with choosing repertoire, please have them contact the school or their music teacher. Original musical scores are required (please speak to the music festival liaison at your school for more info). Your child's class may be participating in the non-competitive classroom singing, choral speech, rhythm band, or dance classes. The festival also offers school, church and community choirs and bands a choice of competitive or non-competitive participation.
